	 Using the wizard, choose "Permissions Inquiry", then "Access request." Select any object or file (or leave default values). Enter title: "Request access to CRRT," upload your Safeguarding PII training certificate on the last page. Click Submit.
	Once you have access, start here with this CRRT overview and documentation.
Personally Identifiable Information (PII)	Once you have an Army Vantage account, if you require PII access for any reason you must first complete the <u>Identifying and Safeguarding Personally Identifiable</u> <u>Information training</u> . Download your Certificate of Completion.
	 Once complete, follow these steps to request access in Vantage and upload your training certificate. Select "Help & support", then "Help Center" near the bottom of the left sidebar menu A new right-side panel opens. At the bottom, click the blue button, "Report an issue" Using the wizard, choose "Permissions Inquiry", then "PII access request." Select any object or file (or leave default values). On the last page, enter title: "Request access to PII, cert attached" and upload your Safeguarding PII training certificate. You will need documented Commander/Supervisor (of the UIC you are requesting higher level access to) approval. This can be accomplished in one of 3 ways: If Commander/Supervisor has a Vantage account, tag them on the issue by typing "@[their name]" in the comments Commander/Supervisor can sign a memorandum indicating they authorize your request; upload to issue ticket Commander/Supervisor can email their approval to usarmy.vantage.support@army.mil
